As foreseen in Article 16 of Council Regulation No 199/2008, the Commission herewith asks the Member States to provide economic information for 2008 and 2009 per segment of the aquaculture sector within their National Data Collection programs as detailed on section A of the Chapter IV, and with the variables listed in Appendix X and the

The data will be processed and analysed by JRC and STECF¹ experts to produce the draft of the first report on the "Economic Performance of EU Aquaculture Sector: Annual Report 2011".

segments listed in Appendix XI of the Commission Decision 2008/949/EC.

We are asking for data on Income (turnover, subsidies and other income), Personnel costs (Wages and salaries of staff and Imputed value of unpaid labour), Energy costs, Raw material costs (livestock costs and feed costs), Repair and maintenance costs, Other operational costs, Capital costs (depreciation of capital and financial costs), Extraordinary costs, Capital value, Net Investments, Debt, Raw material volume (livestock and feed), Volume of sales, Employment (Number of persons employed and FTE national) and Number of enterprises pertaining to the years 2008 and 2009 for the EU aquaculture sector (as detailed in table 1A). Moreover, turnover and volume of sales need to be detailed by species (see table 1B).

Time schedule

Member States are kindly requested to supply the data as specified within one month of the reception of this fax on the data call from the Permanent Representations of the Member States to the EU.

Member States have to use the agreed procedure for transmission of data (by uploading onto the JRC server).

Each Member State requires a password in order to submit data. These passwords remain unchanged from the previous call for economic data. If a Member State no longer has a record of their password, they should contact the JRC data submission team by emailing datasubmission@jrc.ec.europa.eu

We also remind that Member States are legally bound to submit data under the Council Regulation mentioned above, as stated in article 8.5.c. A failure to do so might have implications on the funds allocated to your future data collection program, a situation that the Commission would like to avoid.
